

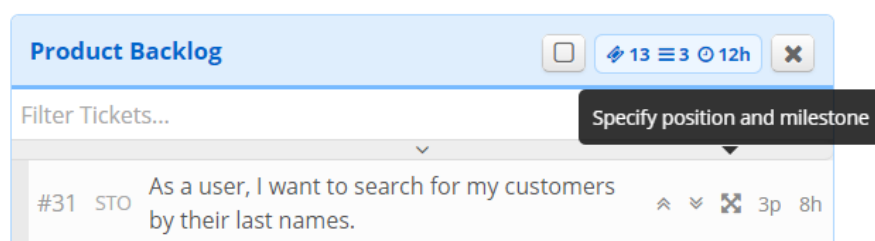

#define is CGI's production system for Application Management and Development, offered in the context of software as a service. It is a project management tool, configuration management system and collaborative workspace; used globally by hundreds of CGI projects.

QUICKLY PRIORITISE BACKLOG

In addition to the existing drag and drop functionality, you can now prioritise tickets in a more convenient way. Simply hover over a ticket on the backlog page and three new icons will appear – allowing you to quickly move a ticket to the bottom of a milestone, the top of a milestone, or a custom position. We hope this will improve the user experience for projects working with a larger number of tickets, and shave a few seconds off your workflow.



STORY POINTS DISPLAYED ON BACKLOG

As the above screenshot also illustrates, the backlog page now displays the story point value for each ticket. We hope this provides agile teams with the information required to quickly and accurately groom their backlog.

RE-INDEXED ATTACHMENTS

We have fixed a bug in our attachment component which was stopping some items from appearing in search results. After a re-index this problem should now be resolved, with all projects supporting full text search.

#DEFINE 3 MIGRATIONS COMPLETED

Over the last 12 months our migration team have helped hundreds of projects move from the old #define platform to #define 4. We hope everyone is now benefiting from the increased functionality and more intuitive user interface. For post migration support please email servicedesk.se@cgi.com
